Inpatient Program Outcomes
January 2010 through December 2010****

- Inpatient population served: 374
- Average age of patient: 66 years old (Ages range from 19-94)
- Total FIM Change from Admission to Discharge: (Daily progress towards independence)
Pinecrest Average = 24 points of improvement
National Average = 24 points of improvement
(FIM: Functional Independence Measure)
- Average length of inpatient stay:
Pinecrest Average is 19.41 days
National Average is 16.72 days
- **80%** of the total inpatient population **returned home** after Rehab at Pinecrest, the national average was only 70%

Patient Satisfaction

Inpatient Rehabilitation

Of those patients surveyed in 2010, 85.5 percent were willing to recommend our services. 90 % said that the staff provided safe patient care.

Outpatient Rehabilitation

Of those patients surveyed in 2010, Outpatient Patient Satisfaction Score was 92.8 (5 Star Status). Of the 300 people surveyed, **96.9 were willing to recommend our services**. In addition, they rated the **overall quality of care and services at 96.3**.
